



SEPTAGE DISPOSAL POLICY

The Town of Shaunavon may allow, for a fee, the dumping of liquid domestic waste by permitted Operators that are operating in accordance with the Saskatchewan Ministry of Environment regulations, to access the Town lagoon for the dumping of their septage upon application to the Town.

For all Operators that apply for access to the Town owned and managed sewage Lagoon; the following procedures be adhered to and followed:

- 1) The Town of Shaunavon requires each applicant provide the Town with a copy of their permit to “*Transport and Dispose of Liquid Domestic Waste*” from the Water Security Agency.
- 2) A \$200 deposit fee per septage disposal account is required before the access will be issued for each mobile phone to be provided access.
- 3) It is the obligation of the Operator dumping septage that there not be any hazardous or prohibited substances in accordance with Saskatchewan Environmental regulations. Fines and costs for damages, and termination of access to the lagoon may be imposed upon any failure to comply.
- 4) The main gate at the lagoon will be securely locked with a padlock. This padlock system provides the Town with an audit trail of activity through the gates.
 - a. The gate is to be closed and securely padlocked upon leaving every time.
 - b. The Operator will be billed based on the information from the Padlock system.
 - c. If the gate is left open for an extended period of time, the Operator will be billed at the discretion of the Town office for multiple loads.
- 5) A fee of \$25 per load be charged for all septic disposals, regardless of volume.
- 6) Operators will be invoiced with payment to be made within 30 days. Non-payment of fees beyond thirty days may terminate access.
- 7) The Town of Shaunavon reserves the right to terminate access to any and all Operators at any time.
