

# CPWC 2021 COVID – 19 Operation Plan

## Entire Facility

- Masks are now mandatory throughout the entire facility for all attendees with the following exceptions:
  - o Children aged 2 years and under
  - o While eating or drinking
  - o While participants under the age of 18 years are on the ice participating in a sport.
  - o While participants 18 years and older are on the ice participating in a sport and are subject to a proof of vaccine policy.

\*Please provide your own mask as they will not be provided for you.

\*Physical distancing between members of different households is always encouraged.

### Entrance & Exit:

- We encourage everyone to use hand sanitizer upon entering the facility and exiting the facility.
- Proof of vaccination is NOT required upon entering the facility, but masks must be worn at all times (with the exception of the circumstances listed above).

## Skating Rink

### Ice Surface

- Masks are to be worn on the ice at all times by all individuals with the following exceptions:
  - o Participants under the age of 18 years while participating in a sport (hockey or figure skating)
  - o Participants 18 years and older only when subject to a proof of vaccination policy (this policy must apply to all participants on the ice during the rental)
  - o All participants aged 2 years and under
- User groups must present their proof of vaccination policy to the Director of Wellness & Leisure prior to their first ice rental. If this is not presented, all individuals 18 years and older will be required to wear a mask at all times while on the ice.

- Masks must be worn on the ice at all times during the following ice times: General Skate, Shiny, and Parent & Tot Skating. (ONLY children aged 2 years and under are exempt from masking during these ice times)

### Dressing Rooms

- Everyone must have a mask on while in the dressing rooms. ONLY those who are in the exception category above may remove their mask when leaving the room to go on the ice.

### Curling Rink

- When entering the CPWC Curling Rink all individuals over the age of 12 years will be required to provide proof of vaccination or a negative COVID-19 PCR or Rapid Antigen test provided by a certified healthcare provider (at the expense of the individual) within the previous 72 hours beginning Nov. 1, 2021.
- Masks will be required to be worn at all times with the exception of on ice play.
- Please follow all other policies as set out by the Shaunavon Curling Club.

### Concession Booth

- Will not offer table service.
- Removal of masks can be done while seated at a table to eat or drink only.

### Lounge

- Proof of vaccination or a negative test result within 72 hours will be required to enter the CPWC Lounge while in operation as outlined is the Government of Saskatchewan Public Health Order. When you enter the lounge area while alcohol is being served, everyone is asked to please go to the bar to present such information.
- As per the Government of Saskatchewan the following are the only acceptable forms of proof of vaccinations:
  - o Wallet cards received at the time of immunization
  - o A printed copy of your MySaskHealthRecord (MSHR) vaccine certificate (with or without a QR code)
  - o A screenshot of your MSHR vaccine certificate (with or without a QR code) saved to your device
  - o An earlier version of your MSHR COVID-19 vaccine certificate
  - o A COVID-19 vaccine printout from Saskatchewan Health Authority Public Health

- Masks will be required to be worn at all times while in the lounge with the exception being while seated at a table or viewing area.
- When getting up to walk to the bar or use the washroom you will be required to once again wear your mask.
