

CPWC 2021 COVID – 19 Operation Plan

Entire Facility

- Masks are now mandatory throughout the entire facility for all attendees with the following exceptions:
 - o Children aged 2 years and under
 - o While eating or drinking
 - o While participants under the age of 18 years are on the ice participating in a sport.
 - o While participants 18 years and older are on the ice participating in a sport and are subjected to a proof of vaccine policy.

Please provide your own mask as they will not be provided for you.

- Physical distancing between members of different households is always encouraged.

Entrance & Exit:

- We encourage everyone to use hand sanitizer upon entering the facility and exiting the facility.
- Proof of vaccination is not required upon entering the facility, but masks must be worn.

Skating Rink

Dressing Rooms

- Everyone must have a mask on while in the dressing rooms, masks can only be removed when leaving the room to go on the ice.

Ice Surface

- Masks are to be worn on the ice by all individuals with the following exceptions:
 - o Participants under the age of 18 years while participating in a sport (hockey or figure skating)
 - o Participants 18 years and older only when subject to a proof of vaccination policy (this policy must apply to all participants on the ice during the rental)
 - o All participants aged 2 years and under
- User groups must present their proof of vaccination policy to the Director of Wellness & Leisure prior to their first ice rental, if this is not presented all individuals 18 years and older will be required to wear a mask at all times while on the ice.

Curling Rink

- When entering the CPWC Curling Rink all individuals over the age of 12 years will be required to provide proof of vaccination or a negative COVID-19 PCR or Rapid Antigen test provided by a certified healthcare provider (at the expense of the individual) within the previous 72 hours beginning Nov. 1, 2021.
- Masks will be required to be worn at all times with the exception of on ice play.
- Please follow all other policies as set out by the Shaunavon Curling Club.

Concession Booth

- Will not offer table service.
- Removal of masks can be done while seated at a table to eat or drink only.

Lounge

- Proof of vaccination or a negative test result within 72 hours will be required to enter the CPWC Lounge while in operation as outlined is the Government of Saskatchewan Public Health Order. When you enter the lounge area while alcohol is being served, everyone is asked to please go to the bar to present such information.
- As per the Government of Saskatchewan the following are the only acceptable forms of proof of vaccinations:
 - o Wallet cards received at the time of immunization
 - o A printed copy of your MySaskHealthRecord (MSHR) vaccine certificate (with or without a QR code)
 - o A screenshot of your MSHR vaccine certificate (with or without a QR code) saved to your device
 - o An earlier version of your MSHR COVID-19 vaccine certificate
 - o A COVID-19 vaccine printout from Saskatchewan Health Authority Public Health
- Masks will be required to be worn at all times while in the lounge with the exception being while seated at a table or viewing area.
- When getting up to walk to the bar or use the washroom you will be required to once again wear your mask.

General Skating, Shinny, Parent & Tot Skate

- Masks will be required to be worn at all times, both on and off the ice unless ages 2 years and under.
- Masks can only be removed by individuals ages 17 years and under when leaving the dressing room and going directly to the ice and the face mask must be worn again when they return to the dressing room.
